WE HEAR GOD'S WORD Scripture Reading

Psalm 37 (ESV)

- Leader: Fret not yourself because of evildoers; be not envious of wrongdoers!
- <u>People</u>: ² For they will soon fade like the grass and wither like the green herb.
- Leader: ³ Trust in the LORD, and do good; dwell in the land and befriend faithfulness.
- <u>People</u>: ⁴ Delight yourself in the LORD, and he will give you the desires of your heart.
- Leader: ⁵Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him, and he will act.
- **<u>People</u>:** ⁶He will bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday.
- Leader: ⁷Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him;
- <u>People</u>: Fret not yourself over the one who prospers in his way, over the man who carries out evil devices!
- Leader: ⁸ Refrain from anger, and forsake wrath! Fret not yourself; it tends only to evil.

- Leader: ¹² The wicked plots against the righteous and gnashes his teeth at him,
- **<u>People</u>**: ¹³ but the Lord laughs at the wicked, for he sees that his day is coming.
- Leader: ¹⁴ The wicked draw the sword and bend their bows to bring down the poor and needy, to slay those whose way is upright;
- <u>People</u>: ¹⁵ their sword shall enter their own heart, and their bows shall be broken.
- Leader: ¹⁶ Better is the little that the righteous has than the abundance of many wicked.

- **<u>People</u>:** ¹⁷ For the arms of the wicked shall be broken, but the LORD upholds the righteous.
- Leader: ¹⁸ The LORD knows the days of the blameless, and their heritage will remain forever;
- **<u>People</u>**: ¹⁹ they are not put to shame in evil times; in the days of famine they have abundance.
- Leader: ²⁰ But the wicked will perish; the enemies of the LORD are like the glory of the pastures; they vanish—like smoke they vanish away.
- <u>People</u>: ²¹ The wicked borrows but does not pay back, but the righteous is generous and gives;
- Leader: ²² for those blessed by the LORD shall inherit the land, but those cursed by him shall be cut off.
- <u>People</u>: ²³ The steps of a man are established by the LORD, when he delights in his way;
- Leader: ²⁴ though he fall, he shall not be cast headlong, for the LORD upholds his hand.
- **<u>People</u>**: ²⁵ I have been young, and now am old, yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken or his children begging for bread.
- Leader: ²⁶He is ever lending generously, and his children become a blessing.
- **<u>People</u>**: ²⁷ Turn away from evil and do good; so shall you dwell forever.
- Leader: ²⁸ For the LORD loves justice; he will not forsake his saints.
- <u>People</u>: They are preserved forever, but the children of the wicked shall be cut off.
- Leader: ²⁹ The righteous shall inherit the land and dwell upon it forever.
- **<u>People</u>**: ³⁰ The mouth of the righteous utters wisdom, and his tongue speaks justice.
- Leader: ³¹ The law of his God is in his heart; his steps do not slip.
- **<u>People</u>**: ³² The wicked watches for the righteous and seeks to put him to death.
- Leader: ³³ The LORD will not abandon him to his power or let him be condemned when he is brought to trial.
