Heidelberg Catechism Q. 106, 107 & 112

- Leader: The sixth commandment is "You shall not murder." Does this commandment refer only to killing?
- <u>People</u>: By forbidding murder God teaches us that he hates the root of murder: envy, hatred, anger and vindictiveness. In God's sight all such are murder.
- Leader: Is it enough then that we do not kill our neighbor in any such way?
- <u>People</u>: No. By condemning envy, hatred, and anger God tells us to love our neighbors as ourselves, to be patient, peace-loving, gentle, merciful, and friendly to them, to protect them from harm as much as we can, and to do good even to our enemie
- Leader: The ninth commandment is "You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor." What is God's will for you in the ninth commandment?
- People:God's will is that I never give false
testimony against anyone, twist no one's
words, not gossip or slander, nor join in
condemning anyone without a hearing
or without a just cause.
Rather, in court and everywhere else,
I should avoid lying and deceit of every
kind; these are devices the devil himself
uses, and they would call down on me
God's intense anger. I should love the
truth, speak it candidly, and openly
acknowledge it. And I should do what
I can to guard and advance my
neighbor's good name.

⁵ Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. ⁶ Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. ⁷ You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. ⁸ But now you must rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. ⁹ Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices ¹⁰ and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator. ¹¹ Here there is no Greek or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all.
